NOAH'S TRAVELER taken in hand early, went up on his own with a three wide run with a quarter mile to go and rallied to edge clear late in a good effort. TEETEE'S TAPIT pressed the pace for a half, gained a short lead at the quarter pole, but could not contain the winner in the final sixteenth. SUNSHINE BOI sat in perfect position, lost the position turning for home but regained the show spot late. STILL SMOLDERING raced evenly and lacked a late response. ALLEY ANTHEM showed good speed to the lead, dueled around the turn and weakened thereafter. HEARTBREAK AFFAIR shuffled back first turn but outrun thereafter. MASS shuffled back early while no threat.
