Footnotes

CARESSING stalked the pace while racing on the outside of rivals, rallied and made a deft move on the turn, drew off through the stretch as the rider pleased and was ridden out to the wire. THE HESS EXPRESS stalked the pace from the middle of the pack, was steadied entering the turn briefly while looking for running room, was clear on the turn but was no match for the winner, gamely held place. DOE NA WANE was well placed in mid pack, improved position but was no factor. SUGAR BOWL stalked the pace in the middle of the pack, ran evenly with no rally. STORMIES AGENDA was good early speed, was through after a half and faded. SHIVE'S GIN MILL stalked the pace, from between horses, was steadied on the backstretch while in tight but was no factor. ESKIMO BABE was away alertly and set the early pace, gave way on the turn and dropped back. POLITICAL MAGIC was never a factor. PERSIAN SILVER showed good early speed but was through after a half and faded. NUPTIALS was no factor and showed little.
