MAJESTIC DINNER stalked and pressed the pace just off the flank of the pacesetter, rallied on the turn and into the stretch, vied for the lead in upper stretch, drew clear mid stretch and was under firm handling to maintain the margin late. RECOGNIZE stalked the pace from mid pack, rallied on the outside on the second turn, reached the front briefly entering the stretch, could not go with the winner but gamely took the place. UNBRIDLED TIME was allowed to set the slow pace while saving ground, was challenged for the lead on the second turn, failed to respond in the stretch, weakened late and was overtaken for the place. FAX A FREDDY was in a good stalking position, rallied on the backstretch and onto the far turn, loomed boldly but then failed to sustain the bid in the stretch. DEADLINE DUDE was unhurried early, improved position in the stretch but was not a threat. C. L. RIB pressed the pace for six furlongs, gave way on the second turn and faded thereafter. FERVENT AFFAIR was unhurried, was not a threat. HUW was no factor, was eased on the second turn and vanned off.
