KICKIN N SCREAMIN unhurried early, rallied into the stretch while roused and ran past the leaders in the final furlong. RAINBOW FLIGHT stalked the leader for a half, gained a short lead at the furlong pole but weakened in the late going. SOFT HIT sprinted to a clear lead, held well to deep stretch but had nothing left for the drive. TRIXIE BEE MINE unhurried early, improved position through the stretch run. ROSIE K had a hedge trip while up close early, dropped back a bit and came again late. RED HOT TRUTH well placed while never far back but lacked the late response when needed. SKIP AWAY STAR showed no speed, moved up late while no real threat. LEMON POP LASSIE trailed early and only passed two. ALY'S SWEET SHEBA failed to menace. SECONDA MIA was through early.
