Reservations closed May 11, 2007. Fees due to remain eligible: \$200 due by June 22, 2007; \$400 by July 27, 2007. \$1,500 to enter by the usual time of closing. The first three finishers in the Cradle Prep may supplement for \$3,000 at the time of entry. A supplemental entry may be made upon payment of \$12,000 at the time of entry. The purse to be distributed: 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth; 3% to fifth; 2% to sixth. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. No owner may start two (2) or more horses to the exclusion of a single entry. Should the race have more entries than management feels can be accommodated, Riverr Downs reserves the right to limit the field to twelve (12) starters with preference given to those with the highest total earnings. Entry fees for excluded horses to be returned. (If transferred to the Main Track, this race will be run at One Mile and a Sixteenth.)

OLD MAN BUCK angled off the rail to race just behind the leaders, moved three wide to challenge on the second turn, gained a short lead soon after, responded willingly in the stretch and held CHEROKEE TRIANGLE at bay under steady urging. CHEROKEE TRIANGLE close up while in hand, moved to a challenging position four wide with three furlongs to go while continuing in hand, reached closest to the winner leaving the second turn, drifted in in midstretch then could not get to that on in the final furlong. CABERNEIGH outrun early, made a good run on the second turn, split rivals on midstretch to reach closest to the top pair but hung. TEEBERRY reserved early, made a three wide middle move but had nothing left late. TIZTHEMANINTHEMOON vied for the lead off the inside, saved ground battling on the second turn but tired in the drive. ARI N JULIUS unhurried early, made a good four wide run to the quarter mile marker but had nothing left late. ROBBING THE BANK alternated for the lead along the inside and tired. TOVAH vied for the lead three wide and gave way. SEASIDE STORM four wide into the first turn, was no factor. BRAVE KNIGHT within striking distance three wide, faded.
