LIVER was away alertly and set the pace while off the rail, drew clear on the backstretch and was under constant urging to hold the margin late. JUICY POINT stalked the pace while never far back, ran evenly and had no late closing response, was still second best. ARCH'S ARROW was unhurried early, rallied on the far turn and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. COPPER CASCADE was well placed and showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. STONE EAGLE dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered in the stretch and faded. IMMORTAL WINK failed to menace. BEAR KIRIDASHI KID was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. SCATTER SHOT was no factor. WHERE'S WINSTON was no threat and was eased in the stretch.
