DELTA EMPERATOR dueled for the lead and pressed the pace from the outside, rallied into the stretch and wore down the leader, drew clear late under firm pressure. CANYON COPPER dueled for the lead and pressed the pace from the outside, took the lead in upper stretch, could not go with the winner but was second best. MELVIN HILL was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. BIG TIME BANKERBOB set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. STRATEGIC DECISION was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. FERRIS showed good early speed, faltered and faded. DR. SIDNEY was well placed early, rallied on the backstretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. BLACKIE CONNORS failed to menace. R OWN MISSILE was no threat. HARD TAFFY was no factor. TWIN COVE was outrun.
