**Footnotes**

DEPUTY WARLOCK was unhurried early, had a steady advance to the second turn, responded well when asked mid stretch, lugged in twice in the stretch and was briefly checked, was under firm handling to the wire. MIGHTY was in a good striking position while never far back, rallied nicely on the second turn, took the lead in mid stretch, drifted out late and was outfinished. PERSONAL FIRST set the pace for three quarters while saving ground, weakened late stretch but was clearly the best of the rest. GO LIB GO was well placed in the middle of the pack, rallied on the second turn and loomed boldly upper stretch but weakened badly in the stretch. HARLAN TRAVELER was in a good position while never far back, rallied, but hung. SOKOL was well placed, rallied on the second turn, but failed to sustain a bid. PIC'S LEGEND was in a good position, had a middle move, but gave way. THREE WONDERS had good early speed while never far back, gave way second turn. BROTHER BOB was no factor, showed little. MIAMI BLASE was well placed while racing inside, was steadied briefly entering the first turn when attempting to bear out and had no rally. GIFTED SCREAMER was pinched back at the start and was no factor. NO LIMIT SOLDIER had good early speed, but was through after a half and dropped back.
