LARDOG duled for the lead and set the pace, drew off in upper stretch, was all out to just last late. SULTRY PLEASURE stalked the pace with good early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late along the rail. KATZMETIC was well placed while never far back, ran evenly with no rally. DRUMSTREET was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. GRRRIFECK was unhurried early, improved position but was no factor. MUSICAL D J was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. CRACKERBOX PALACE failed to menace. GRAND LUCENCI was no threat. R AND R EXPRESS set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded.
