FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. Weight.....120 lbs. \$25 Early Bird nominations closed December 31, 2008. \$300 Last Chance Nominations closed on June 12, 2009. Fees due to remain eligible: Early Bird Nominations to pay \$200 by June 12, 2009; All Nominations to pay \$400 by July 24, 2009. \$1,500 to enter by the usual time of closing. The first three finishers in the Cradle Prep may supplement for \$3,000 at the time of entry. A supplemental entry may be made upon payment of \$12,000 at the time of entry. The purse to be distributed: 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth; 3% to fifth; 2% to sixth. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. No owner may start two (2) or more horses to the exclusion of a single entry. Should the race have more entries than management feels can be accommodated, River Downs reserves the right to limit the field to twelve (12) starters with preference given to those with the highest total earnings. Entry fees for excluded horses to be returned. (If transferred to the Main Track, this race will be run at One Mile and a Sixteenth.)

GLEAM OF HOPE was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch and got through along the rail, drew clear late under firm handling. GUYS REWARD was well placed in mid pack, rallied on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid but gamely held the place. HARRODS CREEK was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. MARATHON MOON dueled for the lead and set the pace, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. EDDIE SET GO set the pace while saving ground, faltered and began to fade. PATHOKI was no factor but improved position. STRIKE THE TIGER stalked the pace on the outside with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. MANO POINT flashed brief speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. SCOTTKEITH'SKITTEN failed to menace.
