PUT BACK THE GOLD set a well handled pace from the inside, drew off heading into the far turn then was in a strong drive in the stretch to hold sway in the end. MY NEW SECRET chased the pace while racing two wide then rallied on the far turn making a strong bid to late stretch but came up empty in the end. TUCKLINO was allowed to settle while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn making a four wide bid then failed to menace in late stretch. WESTERN SECRET was allowed to settle while inside on the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn making a bid in upper stretch but came up empty in the drive. PARADE FOR PEACE was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn but was no menace in the stretch drive. Z STRIKE GOLD chased the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive. GOLDATWORK was allowed to settle while racing four wide on the backstretch, made a four wide middle move on the far turn then faded in the stretch. AVALON OUTLAW was unhurried early and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. IMA FIVE STAR was allowed to settle then faltered. SAINT TINO was on the inside in the early going then swung out to be six wide in upper stretch and was no threat. LITTLEBITOHOPE was four wide on the backstretch and was no factor. STICKSANJU raced five wide on the backstretch and stopped.
