### Footnotes

NATIONAL CLASSIC was unhurried early then started a run on the far turn while racing two wide then swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and closed fast on the outside and was along in time. CATAPULT SHOT was allowed to settle in the early going then rallied on the inside on the far turn, came up the inside in the stretch and was gaining ground but was outfinished in late stretch. CONTROL FREAK was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn, was gaining ground on the outside in the stretch and finished strong. EXPECT MORE dueled for the early lead while two wide then was inside on the far turn and sat down for a long drive but weakened in late stretch. HUNTERBUNTER was unhurried early then rallied along the inside on the far turn and made a mild gain in the stretch but was no menace. DON'S BID stalked the early pace then went up to duel for the lead on the backstretch and far turn while two wide, was in a long drive then gave way in the stretch drive. MORE THAN CAPABLE was unhurried early and raced four wide on the backstretch and lacked a rally in the stretch. SUDDENLY KOOL dueled for the early lead while inside, was used up and was through after a half and stopped. F P DEE AMANTEE was through after a half and stopped. GABRIEL'S MISSION raced five wide on the backstretch and was no factor.
