Footnotes

GOLDATWORK raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased four wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, edged clear inside the furlong marker and proved best under strong urging. PORT LIGHT contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the far turn, battled with GOLDATWORK into the final furlong and weakened late while able to hold the place. AVALON OUTLAW was well placed just off the pace, made a rail bid leaving the backstretch, vied inside on the far turn and tired. BURBERRY BULLET contested the pace on the inside, vied between rivals on the far turn and tired. SAINT TINO raced four wide on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, went four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. LITTLEBITOFHOPE saved ground towards the rear and was no factor. HOLD'EM PAT raced three then four wide on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch and also failed to respond. IMA FIVE STAR raced four then three wide on the first turn and was outrun.
