**Footnotes**

NO SMALL STAR was hustled from the start, moved to the lead and set the pace, dictated terms through the turn, gamely shook off Z STRIKE GOLD in the final furlong and inched clear under strong right hand urging. Z STRIKE GOLD showed good speed, chased the pace, made a bid at the top of the stretch, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished while able to hold the place. PEAK PERFORMER dropped well back in the field, remained well back into the stretch and finished fast but was too late. PORTATE BIEN showed good speed, chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and tired. VORACIOUSLY was ridden along towards the front, moved out on the turn and came up empty. BURBERRY BULLET was ridden along between rivals, raced four then five wide on the turn and also came up empty. COMMA COMMA lacked early speed and failed to respond. TINCY was ridden along while off the pace, raced five then six wide on the turn and had nothing left. SUPER ITRON was void of speed, raced five to six wide early on the turn, moved to seven wide near the quarter-pole and also failed to respond. SEYMOUR NAEVUS was hard ridden towards the front, raced four wide on the turn and faded. MALABAR SLEW was ridden along while off the pace, raced six wide on the turn, dropped to three wide near the quarter-pole and faltered.
