ANDANIGHT was unhurried early and kept to the inside on the turn then started a run and swung out to be seven wide in upper stretch and closed willingly in the stretch to be up for the place in the final stride. TWO JAYS SECRET was settled then rallied on the turn while four wide making a bid but was no threat to the winner then was outfinished for the place in the end. WW CONQUISTADOR raced two wide on turn turn then was blocked between rivals in mid stretch and split horses in late stretch then closed willingly in the end. TATES MANDATE chased the early pace while racing three wide on the turn then made a strong bid to mid stretch but flattened out in the end. RIZZI MONEY was four wide on the turn then made a late gain while outside in the stretch but was no threat. SNOW CAP was well placed while inside on the turn turn and saving ground then faltered in the stretch drive. COOK'S NOOK chased the pace while racing two wide on the turn, made a bid to upper stretch then faltered in the drive. SMART 'N SALTY was in tight early on and taken up and dropped back then raced three wide on the turn and failed to menace in the stretch drive.
