Footnotes

AINTTHATAKICKINTHE dueled for the lead, battled between rivals on the turn, edged clear inside the furlong marker and proved best while eased up late. MAMBO AGAIN chased the pace, dueled inside on the turn and was outfinished. HEAVENLY CONCORDE dueled on the outside then three wide on the turn, drifted out a bit near the furlong marker and weakened. I'M THE CAT jostled with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and failed to rally. Z STRIKE GOLD chased the pace through the turn and tired. FREEDOM EAGLE jostled with a rival at the start, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. Z D'ORS PRINCE broke outward at the start, was hard ridden in the middle of the field and came up empty. SYN RIVER lacked early speed, came three wide into the stretch and showed little.
