STOLI FROM WHO in close, faded. KATINKA STAR little menace. LAYLA DALE broke in, bumped, no threat. APOLLO KING WAYNE avoided bump, no threat. STOLIS LIGHTNING leaned back on rig, slowed gate. A STEWARD'S INQUIRY WAS HELD CONCERNING THE START OF THE RACE. AFTER REVIEW, STOLIS LIGHTNING WAS DEEMED TO HAVE SAT BACK ON THE RIG AS THE GATE WAS OPENING, SO WAS STILL CONSIDER A STARTER.
