SUMMER FASHION vied for the lead from the inside, drew off in mid stretch and was ridden out in the end. SUES HAY saved ground on the turn then rallied along the inside and was gaining ground to be second best. NERVOUS NAEVUS rallied three wide on the turn and was gaining ground to finish well. AERIE BAYADERE vied for the lead from the between rivals, made a strong bid on the turn then faltered in the stretch drive. POWEROFATAKA vied for the lead while three wide, was used up and gave way in the stretch. WINE N SILVER BLUE was in tight early on the backstretch and taken up then rallied on the turn but was no threat. ACTUAL TRAPP was no threat. ADIRUN lugged in backstretch causing crowding then faltered in the stretch. MARY CHARGED IT was no factor. FANCY PROSPECTOR was bumped on the backstretch then was outrun. POLISHED PENNY was in tight quarters then clipped heels with ADRIUN and fell. A steward's inquiry was held concerning the spill on the backstretch. After reviewing the film's, no action was taken and the results stood as is.
