RACIE'S RUNAWAY was allowed to settle into stride, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and closed strongly to get up in the final strides. SPECIAL SENECA chased the pace between rivals, took the lead at the top of the stretch, edged clear into the final furlong and was caught near the wire. TAKE THE BLAME was beaten for speed, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and finished well. FOREVER NAEVUS chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. BABY JEWEL bobbed at the start then was hustled to the lead, pulled clear leaving the backstretch, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and tired. WHISPERIN GIRL settled on the inside of a rival, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. MISS LIL' showed good speed, pressed the pace on the inside, chased BABY JEWEL on the turn and faded. CHRISTAVILLA settled on the outside, raced three wide on the turn and was no factor. DIRTY SECRET settled between rivals, raced off the rail on the turn and showed little.
