BLUE BARRETT brushed with a rival after the start, dueled on the inside, inched clear near the quarter-pole, extended the lead in upper stretch and proved much the best under steady handling. NIGHT RYDE was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, moved out at the top of the stretch and finished willingly for the place. QUEEN ITRON was hustled from the start, dueled on the outside, vied into the stretch and tired while able to hold the show. SIXGUN SALLY leaned out at the start and hit the gate then bumped with a rival, raced near the middle of the field and failed to rally. PENNY PARFAIT jostled with a rival after the start, advanced into third, chased three wide on the turn and came up empty. FIREBOLL was bumped on both sides at the start, raced well back in the field and failed to threaten. MY MASERATTI brushed with a rival after the start, chased the pace near the inside, saved ground on the turn and faded. VALOR STORM was urged along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and failed to respond. TUFF LULA stumbled at the start then dropped back early, raced four wide on the turn and was outrun. J LO'S HALO lacked early speed, saved ground on the turn and showed little.
