No nomination fee. \$200 to pass through the entry box and an additional \$200 to start with \$30,000 Guaranteed of which \$18,000 guaranteed to the owner of the winner, \$6,000 to second, \$3,300 to third, \$1,800 to fourth and \$900 to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$10,000 twice in 2002 allowed 3 lbs.; \$15,000 since March 1, 6 lbs. \$10,000 in 2002, 8 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered in allowances). High weights preferred. Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The field will limited to the number of stalls in the starting gate. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. MISS RITZ stalked the pace while racing four wide, rallied on the outside on the turn to gain command in upper stretch, was in a long drive to prevail in deep stretch. GOODNESS set a pressured pace from the inside, was in a long drive and gamely dug in but tired in late stretch while clearly second best. SLY KONA unhurried early while saving ground, rallied from between rivals in the stretch and was gaining ground in late stretch. S'MORE SMOKE was unhurried early then made a late rally while racing four wide in the stretch. LUCKY M chased the pace while racing three wide, made a bid on the turn then angled out in upper stretch and faltered in the drive. COZY SUSIE pressed the pace from the start, was hard used and gave way in the stretch. LIZZIE ANN showed brief foot and was no factor.
