BUCKABOO rallied three wide on the turn but was no menace in the stretch. LANE'S RIDE was unhurried early then made a mild rally but was no threat. H. C. MYSTERY was settled while inside on the turn but was no threat. BRUTE chased the early pace from the inside, was used up and faltered in the drive. ANDREW'S ALLOWANCE was unhurried early and no threat. EL D broke a step slow then was outrun. VALIDO was no factor.
