MISS DRAGON set the pace under heavy pressure, was joined by WHERE WERE YOU midway through the turn, dueled with that rival through upper stretch, edged clear into the final furlong and held well under strong urging. WILD OVER YOU was beaten for early speed, raced four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished well. WHERE WERE YOU pressed the pace on the outside, drew even midway through the turn, dueled with MISS DRAGON through upper stretch and tired in the final furlong while able to hold the show. LIZZY RIDGE was slow into stride, bumped with LIVEN ON A PRAYER near the six-furlong marker, rushed up on the inside, steadied midway down the backstretch, shifted three wide near the half-mile marker, continued three wide through the turn and faltered. SISTER CAROLINA stumbled badly at the start, dropped to the rear of the field, raced six wide on the turn and was no factor. FAVORITE VICE was forced out after the start, lacked early speed, raced five wide on the turn and failed to threaten. LIVEN ON A PRAYER bumped with LIZZY RIDGE near the three-quarter pole, raced up close while between rivals, dropped back near the half-mile marker, came up empty while saving ground on the turn and retreated.
