Footnotes

AGGORITA dueled on the inside, inched clear entering the final furlong and drew away under strong urging. CHARMING SUSIE was bumped on both sides at the start, chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole but proved no match for the winner while able to get the place. UNBRIDLED FRILL moved out midway down the backstretch while off the pace, dropped to one off the rail on the turn and was along for the show. SOMEWHAT SUE dueled for the lead, vied into upper stretch then gave way. HENERITA MYSTERY broke outward and bumped with a rival, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. JOSLYN STREET bobbled slightly at the start but broke quickly, chased the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn and faded. MORT'S LOTTIE was urged along while just off the pace, raced near the rail on the turn and came up empty. BELABORN raced towards the rear of the field and showed little. SEATTLE STRIKE was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and failed to respond. AHOY BABY saved ground near the back of the field and was outrun. DRAGON LUCK dropped back while under a hold, was ridden along on the turn and faltered then was eased in the final furlong but walked off.
