TERRIFIC SPEED was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, swung out five wide and gained command then drew clear in mid stretch and was ridden out in the end. LUCKY LI'L IMP was on the inside and saving ground, rallied then angled in but was blocked in mid stretch and split rivals to make a late gain to be second best. JUST LIKE ROYALTY was unhurried early then rallied four wide in the stretch, closed willingly but was too late. MONTREAL PRINCESS chased the pace from the inside, made a strong bid going into the far turn then weakened in the stretch. SMART APPEAL stalked the pace while three wide, rallied going into the far turn then faltered in the stretch. OCEANA FLYER failed to menace. PEAKING DIABLO was sent along but bore out on the first, set the pace down the backstretch then gave way in the stretch. CLASSY MISS was on the inside and lacked a rally. SOUTHERNSTURN trailed the field while far back.
