CONGA ROCK bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn, waited a bit outside the quarter-pole, rallied in upper stretch, closed strongly to get the lead then pulled clear and was hand ridden late. LONE STAR BANDIT set the pace, extended the lead midway through the turn, remained well clear into the final furlong but was overtaken and proved no match for the winner. K D KING chased the pace on the inside, saved ground on the turn and came up empty while best of the rest. JOE MOVE raced off the pace while ridden along, was in tight near the three-eighths pole, shifted three wide midway through the turn and came up empty. THUNDERPANTS bumped with a rival at the start, raced well back in the field and was no factor. RUSTED STEEL broke out a bit at the start, pressed then chased the pace and faded. PARKER RUN broke out then hit the gate and was off slow, dropped well behind the field and was eased but walked off.
