SIR JAIME vied for the lead while three wide, was in a long hard drive then drew off in late stretch and held sway in the end. COUGAR'S ARROW was settled then rallied three wide on the turn, was gaining ground while four wide in the stretch and was up for the place in the end. BELLA'S QUEST was well placed while racing five wide into the turn, rallied then angled inside in mid stretch, was gaining ground along he inside in late stretch but came up empty in the end. HEAVY AS METAL was unhurried early then rallied on the turn, was five wide in the stretch and made a mild gain in late stretch but was no menace in the end. JADA BO vied for the lead while four wide on the turn, was hard used then weakened in the late stretch. SECRET ADMIRAL was inside and saving ground on the turn then made a mild rally while inside in the stretch but was no threat. THAT'S OUR ROMEO was inside on the turn and made a mild rally. MASON LANE raced six wide on the turn then was no threat. SERGEANT BO vied for the early lead while two wide, was used up on the turn then gave way in the stretch drive. JOHN LOUIS CLASSIC vied for the lead while inside, was used up then stopped. ROAD HAWK was outrun. ETHEREAL FLAME raced five wide on the turn and was outrun.
