TROUBLE NOW was urged along while off the pace, came three wide into the stretch, closed strongly to get the lead inside the furlong marker then powered clear under strong urging. EYE WONDER dueled on the outside, edged clear midway through the turn, was collared inside the furlong marker and weakened while well clear for the place. WINDY LOU lacked early speed, saved ground on the turn and was best of the rest. MUCHO GATO broke outward at the start, lacked early speed, shifted three wide midway through the turn and failed to threaten. WEE BE GONE dueled on the inside, dropped out midway through the turn and faded. HOW'S THAT was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide early on the turn then dropped to one off the rail and came up empty.
