(PLUS UP TO \$4,000 Open ATB) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$300 to pass through the entry box and an additional \$300 to start with \$50,000 Guaranteed of which \$30,000 guaranteed to the owner of the winner, \$10,000 to second, \$5,500 to third, \$3,000 to fourth and \$1,500 for fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$10,000 twice in 2008 allowed 3 lbs.; \$15,000 since March 1, 2008, 6 lbs.; \$10,000 in 2008, 8 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered in allowances). High weights preferred. Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The field will be limited to (14) fourteen horses. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. If less than (5) five horses start, the purse money not distributed will revert to the winning owner. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Wednesday, August 27, 2008 with (14) fourteen nominations.

Footnotes

RUFFAROUNDTHEEDGES was urged along while off the pace, raced four to five wide on the turn, closed fast to get the lead outside the sixteenth-pole then powered clear under left hand urging. MS CLASSIC SENECA was ridden along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn, steadied off heels inside the quarter-pole and finished willingly for the place. MORNING RIDGE bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace, made a bid midway through the turn, led into the final furlong but was overtaken. FORMAL FLYER was hard ridden while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and came up empty. DO THE TIGER lacked early speed, came between rivals near the furlong marker and failed to rally. EYES ON THE GOLD bobbed at the start, moved up to race just off the pace, steadied outside the quarter-pole, steadied again inside the quarter-pole then lacked the needed response. TWISTED TALE lacked early speed, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. VALID LILLY was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and dropped out. SUZY THREE bumped with a rival at the start, set the clear pace, lost the lead nearing the quarter-pole and gave way.
