Non-winners of \$15,000 twice in 2000 allowed 3 lbs.; \$20,000 since March 1, 6 lbs.; \$10,000 in 2000, 8 lbs.; \$7,500 since March 1, 10 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances). High weights preferred. Total earnings in 1999-2000 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight. The maximum number of starters for the race will be limited to (12) twelve. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. Closed Wednesday, August 30, 2000 with (27) twenty-seven nominations. (Plus Up To \$2,800 from ATBOIA.).



SOUTHERN IVY clipped heels in the first turn, quickly regained stride then was allowed to settle down the backstretch then was boxed entering the far turn and angled out five wide for the drive to prevail. JUNGLE SUN was unhurried early then made a seven wide bid at the upper stretch and rallied well to be up for the place. MISS CLOVER was well placed on the inside then boxed on the far turn then angled out in the stretch for room and rallied. HE SITS HE SIPS was void of early speed then was closing fast but lacked room in the stretch. SEEMSLIEAROCKET pressed the pace to the stretch and weakened. JIFFY WISH was void of early speed and lacked a rally. NOBODY'S FOOL prompted the pace four wide and gave way in the drive. VICTORIA ALY set the pace to upper stretch and faded in the lane.
