LITTLE ONION was inside heading into the turn, was blocked nearing the middle of the turn, rallied two wide in the stretch and was gaining ground while in a strong drive, dug in gamely and was along in time to proved best in the end. BALDACCI chased the early pace then rallied two wide on the turn, moved to the inside and powered up to take command in upper stretch, dug in gamely throughout the stretch drive but was outfinished in late stretch. JALOPE JOE was allowed to settle then rallied four wide on the turn, made a bid to mid stretch then flattened out in late stretch. ZAP A PRINCE was unhurried early then rallied along the inside in the stretch to closed ground willingly in late stretch. FUZZY HAT set the early pace, was hard used on the turn then weakened in late stretch. SAFARI GOLD was unhurried early and was no threat. STORMIN' TREVOR was unhurried early while racing two wide and was no factor. BEAU'S LEGEND was through after a half and faltered. DO'S DRIZZLE had no speed and was outrun. PERSONAL MISSILE chased the early pace while inside then stopped.
