HOMEMAKER broke inward slightly at the start, was beaten for early speed, advanced near the half-mile marker, engaged the leader midway through the turn, took over in upper stretch and edged clear under a hand ride to win with plenty left. MISS LIL' was sent hard from the start, set the clear pace, lost the lead at the top of the stretch, vied into the final furlong and proved no match for the winner late. MISS DRAGON tracked the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and went evenly. BLONDZ AWAY lacked early speed, raced four wide on the turn, angled to the rail outside the quarter-pole and failed to rally. LACEY DAWN broke outward at the start, raced near the back of the compact field, dropped back while three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. MEDIOLUNA MISTRESS was allowed to settle into stride, dropped back while off the rail on the turn and faded.
