MAJESTIC TREE was well handled while setting a slow pace, was in complete control then responded with a strong burst on the far turn and dug in gamely throughout the stretch drive and proved best in the end. BIG SCRAPE was well placed while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied two wide on the far turn making a strong bid to upper stretch but hung in the end. PRACTICE TEE was stalking the early pace while racing on the inside, made a bid in upper stretch but came up empty in late stretch. DANDY'S LEGACY was three wide on the backstretch while being well placed, made a bid into the far turn then faltered. MACEDONIAN was unhurried early then was no menace in the stretch. ROAD WORK was three wide on the run down the backstretch, was used up then faltered.
