Footnotes

MIGHTY O'MALLEY dueled on the inside, pulled clear with three furlongs to run, widened the margin in upper stretch and proved much the best under strong right hand urging. LIGHTSNATCHER was never far back, chased the winner while three to four wide on the turn and was only second best. MFAZI raced between rivals in the second flight, moved to the rail midway through the far turn, vied into the stretch and gave way while clearly best of the rest. IMA RED RUNNER broke slowly then was hard ridden at the back of the field, raced four wide on the turn, angled to the rail near the quarter-pole and improved position without threatening. MAGIC MARTY chased the pace between rivals, came up empty near the three-furlong marker and retreated. FROSTY HALO dropped well back in the field, raced four wide on the turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and was no factor. BEAUTIFUL JOYCE bumped with DOBBINS FUEGO after the start, raced five wide on the turn and showed little. CRAFTY PRINCE was very reluctant to load, raced on the inside while ridden along and was through early. DOBBINS FUEGO bumped with a rival after the start, dueled on the outside, stopped midway through the turn and was eased in the final furlong then walked off.
