Footnotes

COOK'S NOOK chased the early pace while racing two wide on the turn, rallied on the outside and was in a long drive and powered to the front in late stretch to proved best in the end. CUSTOM JET set the pace, drew off into the turn while in a hard drive then weakened in late stretch. EDPLICIT was unhurried early then moved to the inside on the turn, was closing ground willingly in the stretch while inside but was too late. MR. ROAD WARRIOR raced two wide on the turn making a bid then flattened out in late stretch. SEMICONDUCTOR raced three wide on the turn and was no threat. INTIMIDATING MONEY raced four wide on the turn and was no factor. EARLY ROCKIN was through early on and stopped.
