**Footnotes**

CAT FROM ROME stalked the early pace while racing two wide then rallied on the turn, was in a strong drive then proved best in the end. UNCLE GRINGO was settled then rallied five wide on the turn, was gaining ground on the outside and up for the place in the end. DOUBLE EDGE STORM set the early pace, drew off on the turn then weakened in late stretch. MAXUM MEMENTO stalked the early pace while inside then made a bid but flattened out in late stretch. BUBBA KIP rallied four wide on the turn making a bid then flattened out in the stretch. TIO was unhurried early then raced three wide on the turn, made a mild rally in the stretch but was no threat. BOBBIE M'S BOY was two wide early on the shuffled back and was no threat. HAWAIIAN DISCO raced four wide on the turn and was no threat. FUNNY FOREST was three wide on the turn and no factor. STORMY CREOLE was unhurried early and was no factor. COSTAMYINHERITANCE showed good early speed, was three wide while being used up and stopped.
