Footnotes

BRIDAL GAL was allowed to settle on the inside, rallied four wide into the stretch, closed strongly to take the lead near the sixteenth-pole then edged clear under steady handling. SHANNONS VALENTINE was bumped at the start, tracked the pace while three wide, made a bid midway through the turn, vied into the final sixteenth then proved no match for the winner. ACLEVERSHADEOFJADE was taken back after the start, moved between rivals midway through the turn, shifted four wide inside the quarter-pole, floated five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. FIVE STAR MEETING broke outward and bumped with a rival, pressed the pace down the backstretch, made a bid while between rivals midway through the turn, vied into upper stretch and faded. COOKIN'S CAST settled on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. SENECA SONG set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn and stopped.
