RERUN THEM BONES set the pace from the start, drew off in upper stretch then was kept to task in the end. WAR HYMN was settled early on then rallied coming out of the turn, moved out to be five wide in upper stretch an was gaining ground to finished well in the end but was no threat to the winner. MALABAR SLEW was settled early on then rallied four wide in the stretch, was gaining ground but was no menace in the end. COOPERS GULCH was saving ground on the turn then stayed inside in the stretch but was no threat in the end. UNA DE GATO pressed the early pace while inside, was hard used then faltered in the stretch drive. ALL THERE was unhurried early then angled inside to saved ground, raced inside in the stretch but was no threat. AIR FLIGHT chased the early pace while racing three wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. AINT THAT RIGHT raced three wide on the turn and failed to menace. RANDALL COUNTY was two wide on the turn and failed to threaten in the stretch drive. TEXAS TALL TALE was four wide on the turn and failed to menace. ARCTIC SEARCH was four wide on the turn, was used up and faltered in the stretch drive. PRIMED PIONEER bobbed soon after the start and was pulled up by his rider and vanned off.
