Footnotes

RETAS RUNNER pressed the pace, vied between rivals on the far turn, battled gamely in the stretch and narrowly prevailed. WACO HUG lagged at the rear of the field, passed rivals on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly to just miss. BOUNCE HOUSE set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and weakened. PUT BACK THE GOLD raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, vied three wide on the far turn, jostled with a rival near the five-sixteenths pole and dropped back then also weakened. GENERAL HONORE raced four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, jostled with PUT BACK THE GOLD while four wide on the far turn, dropped to three wide near the quarter-pole and came up empty. BURBERRY BULLET raced four to five wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along on the far turn and also came up empty. RACIN EXPRESS settled towards the rear of the field, raced three to four wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. GENTLEMAN JOE raced three to four wide on the first turn, lingered towards the back and was no factor. TYLER B broke inward and a bit slow, settled on the inside and retreated.
