GOODNESS set the pace from the inside, drew clear on the turn under good handling and was kept to mild pressure while clearly the best. MISS RITZ saved ground on the turn then rallied, was gaining ground but was no threat to the winner. NOBODY'S FOOL was unhurried early then made a late rally while six wide to finish well. JUNE SPENDER raced three wide on the turn, made a mild gain in the stretch. OUTFOFNOWHERE broke in the air then made a four wide move to upper stretch then hung in late stretch. SLY KONA failed to menace. BRICKETTA chased the pace while three wide, was used up and weakened in the drive. LITTLE ANGEL pressed the pace while between rivals, was hard used and gave way in the stretch. DISCOS PEARL was outrun and no threat.
