LADY TWANG dueled for the lead from the inside, drew off in mid stretch then was kept to task in late stretch while clear. J GRAY was saving ground on the turn then rallied but was no match for the winner in the end. WITH A DANCE was unhurried early then made a late rally while four wide in the stretch but was no menace. SANDIPAT was allowed to settle while racing three wide on the turn then failed to menace. SIERRA WILD dueled for the lead while two wide on the turn, was used up then faltered in the stretch. LUV DUMP raced three wide on the turn making a bid then faltered in the stretch. LIL BIT NAUGHTY was unhurried early then made a late gain but was no factor. STAR SHOOTER was no threat. UNEEDA BISCUIT was far back and trailed throughout.
