SOLAR CHARGE stalked the early pace then moved out to be four wide into the turn, loomed boldly in the middle of the turn and powered up to take command, drew off in late stretch and was clearly much the best in the end. DELIVERER was unhurried early then rallied on the turn, swung out to be six wide in upper stretch, was gaining ground and was up for the place in the end. MALABAR SLEW vied for the lead from the inside, drew off into the turn then was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. MASTER TIME vied for the early lead while two wide, was used up then gave way. HONKYTONK STOMP vied for the lead while three wide, was used up and faltered. BAGGY CAT vied for the early lead while four wide into the turn, was hard used then stopped. SPEED MONSTER trailed throughout.
