SANIBEL SUNSET drifted in at the start, settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, rallied in upper stretch, shifted out near the furlong marker and closed strongly to win going away. WASIOTO jostled with a rival after the start, raced three to four wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, took the lead at the top of the stretch, led into the final furlong but was collared outside the sixteenth-pole and proved no match for the winner. ANNIE'S HONOR contested the pace, battled back gamely when headed at the top of the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. PROUD CARMELA broke inward and bumped a rival, was reserved off the pace, roused near the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. TRUTH BY RUTH was very reluctant to load, rated between rivals, was roused on the far turn and failed to respond. SMART APPEAL was bumped at the start, settled well off the pace, raced three wide on the second turn and failed to threaten. ERIMOS (IRE) raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer while off the rail on the second turn and came up empty. LADY ITRON jostled with a rival after the start, raced three wide on the first turn and showed little. DARING WIT was bumped at the start, raced well back in the field and was outrun. BAILEYS QUEEN bumped with a rival at the start, tracked the pace on the inside, came up empty leaving the backstretch and stopped. (Rail at 0 Feet)
