Footnotes

GLASS MACHINE quickly tracked the leader from the outside, drew on even terms at the three-eighths pole while two wide, was called on at the top of the stretch and began to edge away before going under a hand ride inside the sixteenth pole. WEE BE GONE was ridden along to take the early lead along the rail, overtaken at the top of the stretch and could not match strides with the winner. LIVE PROSPECT chased the early leaders, was two wide on the turn and had no rally. RIZZI MONEY raced along in midpack, mounted a rally at the quarter-pole, was five wide on the turn and hung through the stretch. HEZA TWELTH MAN was allowed to settle toward the back of the pack, advanced along the rail at the three-eighths pole but had to check leaving the turn and did not pose a serious threat after that. HONORABLE LIFE was ridden hard past the half mile pole to stay within striking distance of the leaders, found his best stride nearing the quarter-pole but was five wide leaving the turn and tired in the stretch. HAYYARD BRANCH was hurried along to duel for the early lead between horses and tired at the three-eighths pole. STORMY UPRISING showed little.
