COL. WRIGHT raced six wide into the first turn then angled in then was allowed to settle, started a run into the far turn then moved out to be four wide, was in a long drive on the outside and was along in time. ICY BLIZZARD stalked the early pace while racing on the inside, rallied inside heading into the far turn and gained a slim lead on the far turn then was in a long drive and dug in gamely but hung in late stretch. MASON LANE broke in and bumped at the start then was sent right to the front to set the pace, was in a long drive on the far turn and gamely dug in but weakened in late stretch. TEXAS CITIZEN was allowed to settle on the backstretch while racing four wide, rallied on the far turn and stretch two wide but came up empty in late stretch. COUGAR'S ARROW was six wide into the first turn then angled in on the run down the backstretch but failed to menace when asked in the stretch. OOPS AND A HALF chased the early pace while racing two wide, was used up on the far turn and gave way. FASTERHANYOUTHINK was unhurried early then raced three wide on the far turn but was no factor in the stretch. MAGIC INTERLUDE bore out on the first turn while being used up, stopped then was eased up in the stretch while drifting out in the stretch drive.
