BROWN EYED SUGAR on the inside and vying for the lead, was headed on the far turn and roused strongly to overtake MISS TESTER and drew clear of that one in mid stretch and was kept to pressure late. MISSING TAB was well placed behind the early pacesetters then rallied three wide on the far turn, was gaining ground to be second best. MISS TESTER vied for the lead while two wide, took command in between calls then faltered in the stretch drive. MYSTIC PINE was in tight on the first then vies for the lead while three wide, was hard used then weakened in the stretch. ALWAYS A GAMBLE vied for the lead while four wide, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch. LOST RECITAL IRON was allowed to settled then made a mild four wide bid in the stretch but was no threat. RED RIVER ROSE was settled then made a mild bid while five wide in the stretch but failed to menace. WINE N SILVER BLUE was in tight quarters on the first turn and was no threat. DODGE CITY GIRL was unruly in the gate and was no factor. ICYROUNDTABLE was in tight quarters on the first turn and bumped soundly then was no factor. TAMMY'S SURPRISE raced four wide on the backstretch while stalking the pace then gave way. MARY CHARGED IT on the inside and stopped in the stretch.
