B G GIFT EXCHANGE chased the early leader, pulled even with five-sixteenths remaining, soon drew clear while racing two wide on the turn, came under a right-handed whip at the top of the stretch until the rider tucked it away past the sixteenth-pole while holding on for the win. PULL OVER PARIS settled just past midpack, found room near the rail to pass the tiring JADA FLEET with a quarter mile left, then angled back out to be about three wide before leaving the turn, rallied but did not get there in time. B G TOP YANKEE soon passed the early leader, was challenged with five-sixteenth to go while racing along the rail, passed but tried to come back again in the stretch before settling for show. MY DESTROYER broke out sharply at the start but soon settled behind the leaders, was five wide on the turn and posed no threat. STAR PACKER broke toward the back of the pack and made a mild advance. JADA FLEET allowed to run to the early lead but soon was passed and could not keep up. GO JONESY GO was unhurried away from the gates, looked to make a slight advance while two wide on the turn but never mounted a serious threat. SMART LIKE THAT was ridden along early in an effort to keep contact with the early pace but soon retreated.
