SIR JAIME challenged for the early advantage, racing between rivals around the turn and pulled away down the stretch. AT THE BRINK raced within striking distance, came around the turn five wide, proved no match for the winner, but got up for second. QUIET DOMINATION lacked early speed and gained ground late. SEATTLE SAL raced in the middle of the field, made a late bid and missed third. LE SEUR raced in the back in the early part, showed late interest, but was no factor. FIREBALL'S ACE pressed the pace, came around the turn three wide and weakened. BEST AFFAIR raced within contention, saved ground and faded. COOK'S NOOK raced in the middle of the field and put forth an even effort. THE TAP void of early speed and was never a threat. MIDWAY TAP raced near the back and lacked a bid. BIG TONY lacked early speed and was outrun. FAN CLUB went to the front, retreated and was eased.
