CHAUFFE AU ROUGE was well rated on the inside, then swung out four wide at the top of the stretch for racing room, then drew clear in the final furlong to prove best under a drive. GOLD NUGGET set a pressured pace, then was headed at the eighth pole and proved to be no match to the winner, while staying on for the place gamely. TIN SMITHEEN stalked the pace to the top of the stretch, then made a bid to go on even terms for the lead, but flattened out late to just miss the place. PARIS SAVAGE was bumped at the start, then angled out in the stretch to have a mild rally. D C STORM was allowed to settle then was four wide at the top of the stretch but had no rally. ZIGFIRE lacked a rally. LIGHTS ON BROADWAY chased the early pace then weakened. CHIEF THREE SOX was through after a half. HOPEFUL ARROW was allowed to settle then tired.
