PRINCESS GAGA vied for the early lead, took command around the final turn, drove clear and was kept to the task. MY HONKYTONK ANGEL pressed the pace, saved ground around the second turn, proved no match for the winner, but was a clear second. HALO'S JUBILEE raced within striking distance, made a mild bid, but proved no match for the top two. GREAT EYES lacked early speed, improved position, but was no factor. ARDYTHE MCGEE raced evenly near the back in the early going, made a mild bid, before fading down the home stretch. DAPPER GIRL went to the front, drove clear, saved ground and was finished early. LADY MELROSE raced evenly in the middle of the pack and retreated. MISS SERENA trailed throughout and was never a threat.
